A Brief Report

India's first-ever dedicated expo for stainless steel industry concluded on a successful note

Virgo Communications and Exhibitions successfully hosted the first-ever GSSE 2022: Global Stainless Steel Expo powered by Jindal Stainless and supported by the Ministry of Steel, Government of India from 12th to 14th April at Jio World Convention Centre, Mumbai.

The 3-day conclave provided an exclusive platform for the stainless steel industry stakeholders which included manufacturers, buyers, influencers, regulators, industry associations and media, to converge under one roof. The exhibition spread across 5000 sq. mts. space offered 80+ producers an opportunity to network, showcase products, build presence, and engage with their target audience and explore business opportunities. The exhibition was well attended by about 8000 trade visitors which included industry captains from the country and beyond.

GSSE presented a gateway to various end-user industries to familiarize themselves with cutting edge technology from across the world, deliberate on emerging business trends during knowledge-packed topical sessions, lay down a road map to accelerate industry's growth and jointly devise ways to reclaim India's position as second largest stainless steel producer. Incidentally, the cyclical and structural factors have been driving growth in the country's stainless steel segment post the pandemic. The event indeed helped the industry to leverage and discuss issues pertinent to the growth of India's stainless steel industry and solutions needed to raise the bar for the whole country in the stainless steel ecosystem comprising of suppliers, users, traders, associations, regulators, and makers.

Inauguration

The maiden B2B exhibition-cum-conference was inaugurated by Chief Guest, Smt. Rasika Chaube, Addl. Secretary, Ministry of Steel, Govt. of India in presence of Mr. Abhyuday Jindal, MD, Jindal Stainless; Mr. Prakash Sanghvi, CMD, Ratnamani Metals & Tubes; Mr. K K Pahuja, President, Indian Stainless Steel Development Association (ISSDA) and Mr. Sanjeev Taneja, ED (SSP), SAIL.

Smt. Rasika Chaube, Addl. Secretary, Ministry of Steel, Govt. of India during the inaugural address complimented Virgo Communications and Exhibitions and Indian Stainless Steel Development Association (ISSDA) for joining hands to establish a dedicated stainless steel industry platform in India. She also acknowledged that raw material like Chromium is in good supply but Nickel is not available and the government is aware of this challenge being faced by the Indian stainless steel industry. She stated that the Ministry of Steel has managed to get zero duty on scrap extended up to March 2023. She also assured that Steel Ministry has taken up the matter to remove duty on ferronickel with the Finance Ministry to reduce the input cost since it's a very important raw material required for the manufacturing of corrosion-free steel which is used in various sectors like Auto, Defence, Railways and Infrastructure. However, she cautioned that such decisions are taken after a lot of considerations by the Finance Ministry, and the Steel Ministry can only make recommendations for the same.










Stainless Vision 2047

A brief research report Stainless Vision 2047 prepared by CRISIL in close coordination with ISSDA was also released by Smt. Rasika Chaube, Addl. Secretary, Ministry of Steel, Govt. of India during the Inaugural. The findings of the report aligned with new aspirational India and overall vision of the Ministry of Steel. The report stated that domestic stainless steel demand is expected to reach 20 million tonne (MT) by fiscal year 2047.

The report highlighted that India is the second largest consumer of stainless steel and one of the fastest growing markets. The country's per capita stainless steel consumption has more than doubled to 2.5 kg in 2022 fiscal from 1.2 kg in 2010. In 2021-22, the country's demand for stainless steel was 3.7-3.9 MT and as of March 2022, India's installed stainless steel capacity is at 6.6-6.8 MT. The capacity utilization is estimated to have improved from 50 per cent in 2021 fiscal year to 58-60 per cent in 2022.

The industry is further expected to register a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 6.6-7.5 per cent over fiscals 2022-2025 and reach 4.6-4.8 MT. Further, the consumption is expected to reach 12.5-12.7 MT and 19-20 MT by fiscal years 2040 and 2047 respectively. Remarkably, sectors like Construction, Infrastructure and Manufacturing are expected to drive the industry's growth and become key contributors to the country's GDP. The report claimed India needs to develop enough capacities while improving the utilization to meet the estimated demand. The per capita consumption of stainless steel will reach 8-9 kg by 2040 and 11-12 kg by 2047. The growth is set to jump by leaps and bounds owing to the government spending across various sectors where stainless steel is mainly used.






